The Biblical Studies Major is for those individuals who are called to church ministry in capacities other than as a pastor. This program of study is designed to provide a balanced education in general studies, Bible and theology, and courses specific to one of three minors:

- Christian Counseling
- Christian Education
- Christian Music/
Worship Leading

Students who complete the training will have a foundation upon which to build a successful ministry as a Christian education director or music minister/worship leader, or a foundation in Christian counseling for pursuit of a master’s degree and licensing as a counselor.

Although this is considered a four-year degree, it may take longer to complete the program depending on the course load per semester.

Courses are offered on campus or online. On campus courses last 16 weeks. There are two eight-week sessions of online courses per semester and there is one eight-week session of online classes offered during the summer break.
