We appreciate your interest in Heritage Bible College. Our mission is to develop Christ-centered men and women of Christian character, equipped at the college level with skills for ministry and committed to a life of Christian service. We offer Bachelors of Religious Education with majors in Biblical Studies, Pastoral Ministry (which includes Leadership studies), or Worship and Music. Students who elect to earn the B.R.E. in Biblical Studies may choose one of these tracks: Christian Counseling, Discipleship, Missions and Evangelism, or Youth Ministry. We also offer an Associate in Christian Studies for students who wish to begin their college education with foundational courses in the Bible and general studies then transfer to a secular four-year institution to earn their bachelor's degree. Transfer credits are subject to approval by the four-year college or university of the student's choice.

This information packet should answer many of your questions regarding our college and the services we offer:

- Day, night, and online classes
- Federal Financial Aid and Institutional Scholarships
- Federal work study program

Our day classes on campus meet on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Evening classes on campus meet once per week on Monday, Tuesday, or Thursday. Most of our courses are also offered online. This gives students some flexibility in completing a degree and the possibility of working around job, family, and church responsibilities. Enrollment may be full-time (12 or more credit hours) or part-time.

From the Financial Aid Office

Dear Prospective Student:

We are excited and greatly encouraged by your interest in Heritage Bible College. We know the decision to attend Bible College is one you have come to with much prayer. It is a step of faith, one which not all your friends and family may understand or support but it is one that will be worth it. You may still have some questions in how all the details will come together. One of your main concerns may be the expense of tuition. As the Financial Aid Director at the college, it is my job to assist you in choosing the best payment plan for your situation.

We are a Title IV approved school and are able to offer our students who qualify financial assistance. The steps to complete this process are:

- 1.) Visit www.fafsa.ed.gov and create a Federal Student Aid (FSA) ID. This includes a username and password. **Save this information.** (You will reuse the FSA ID *every* year you are a student.)
- 2.) Begin entering your information in the FAFSA.
- 3.) On the Financial Information tab, try and to **use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool.** This allows your financial information to be verified accurately.
- 4.) Be sure to include the College's code **030893**, so that we receive your information.
- 5.) Sign and submit your FAFSA electronically

Upon submission of your FAFSA, the college will receive your information in one to three days. We will then contact you to discuss your eligibility for grants and student loans. This information is based on your EFC (Expected Family Contribution).

The maximum Pell Grant amount to be awarded is \$5775. Many of our students find they are eligible for some financial assistance. Be sure to complete your FAFSA.

It is very rewarding to work with our students in helping to ensure that they find a way to pay for their college expenses. Please, do not hesitate to ask me any questions you may have. There are also appointment times available in which I assist students with the FA (Financial Aid) process in my office.
